

# Washakie #1 Online Guidelines

The district is offering online curriculum to home bound and home school students as well as serving students who need credit recovery and course work that provides enrichment opportunities.

## Basic Guidelines

Students who are interested in Washakie #1 Online must be approved through an application process.

Washakie #1 Online is a very rigorous curriculum that is best suited for students who demonstrate personal responsibility.

The district will provide a laptop computer for online students who participate full-time in our online curriculum.

Eligibility for activities associated with Wyoming High School Activities Association (WHSAA) will be monitored and based on progress toward completion of milestones established by K<sup>12</sup> standards.

A certified district employee will oversee and monitor student progress.

Online students will receive notices to participate in peer/class activities throughout the school year.

Washakie #1 Online students will be eligible to participate in the district graduation ceremony but will not be eligible for valedictorian or salutatorian status.

Washakie #1 Online students will be allowed to enroll in district on-site courses through an application process. The maximum number of courses will be two per semester.

- Upon approval for on-site courses, students will be required to arrive on time and depart immediately following class. Signing in and out at the school office is required.
- Elementary students will take on-site courses and required assessments in their boundary school and according to their grade level.

Washakie #1 Online students will be required to participate in District and State assessments including MAP, PAWS and ACT (according to grade level). Additional assessments are available if desired.

## **Enrichment and Credit Recovery Students**

Students who wish to participate in online enrichment/credit recovery courses will be given an opportunity to do so through the application process. An approved application will include parent permission, teacher recommendation with data support, administrative permission, and available funding.

Students who sign up for online enrichment/credit recovery courses will be required to submit a \$75 deposit, which will be returned at the successful completion of the course. The deposit will not be returned for students who fail or drop these courses. Scholarships will be made available for students with financial hardship.
